Procedure of minimizing, eliminating or alleviating any adverse impact as well as plans for future monitoring programmes is also included for guidance.

The guidelines if properly followed shall assist the project proponent(s) in conforming with the requirements of EIA Acts of 2017, and to obtain certification from the Federal Government of Nigeria through the FMEnv.

The existence of these guidelines does not in any way preclude the project proponents from complying with other applicable laws and regulations and laws. The agency reserves the right to modify or replace these guidelines in whole or in part as deemed fit in the circumstances without notice.
